TIME TO DO YOUR PAPERWORK

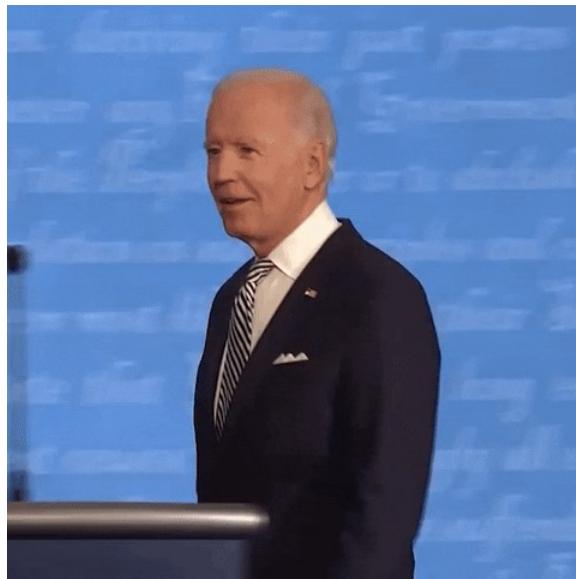
- The backbone of the building renovation is Tenant Income Certifications

- Island Terrace Apartments received assistance from the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022

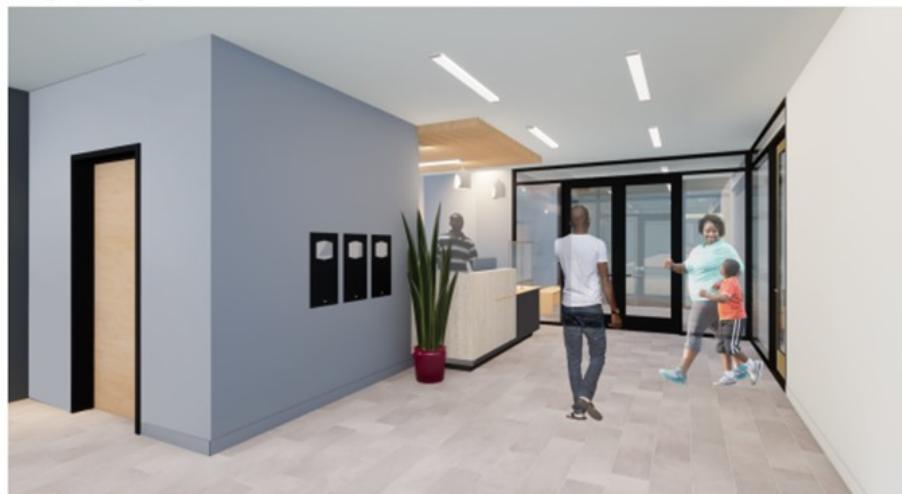

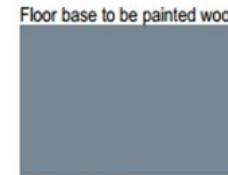

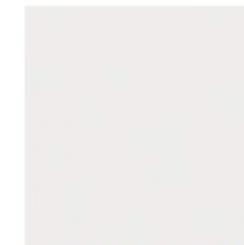

Proposed Construction Timeline

- **Jan 2024- September 2025 – Common areas will start BEFORE UNITS**
 - Plumbing and ventilation replacement begins!
 - YOU WILL BE GETTING LOTS OF NOTICES AND VISITS FOR MEASUREMENTS!
- **Feb – June 2024 – Walsh GMA garage demolition and site work**
 - We are arranging alternative locations for people who currently pay for parking –we will have a follow up meeting when we have firmed up all the details.
- **May 2024 – October 2025 - unit work will begin from the 22ⁿ floor down**
 - Walsh/GMA will be renovating 2 floors at a time
 - Residents are expected to relocate while we work on their apartments for approximately 6-8 weeks
- **December 2024- September 2025 – Common areas to be worked on AFTER UNITS**
 - Community and Laundry room (December 2024- February 2025)
 - Mail room (December 2024- January 2025)
 - Bike room (March 2025)
 - Trash rooms (March 2025)

Relocation Happens in Two Phases

Phase 1 - Individual household consultations – now through May 2024

1. Urban Relocation Services (URS) is conducting household consultations with every resident!
2. This is separate from the tenant income certifications (that is POAHC)-you have to do both!
3. Household interviews are confidential
4. POAH Community Impact to assist residents and URS
5. We recommend that you are honest with URS regarding ALL YOUR household needs. They are here to help you the resident make this process as seamless as possible

Phase 2 – Planning Your Move

1. You will have to move out of your apartment for 6-8 weeks
2. POAH will provide lodging **AT NOT COST TO YOU**
3. URS will help with relocation logistics to make the process as seamless as possible
4. Notices will be given 30 days prior to your move out date

Tips for Purging and Packing

- Purge all items you don't need in bathrooms and kitchens before you move
- Check expiration dates on food items and throw away anything past its prime
- Limit purchasing or bringing in items from the outside
- Anything you are worried about remaining in your unit, can be placed in storage
- Moving boxes and tape will be distributed to everyone prior to their move
- Label every box by room
- Consider donating items that are in good condition but don't serve you anymore
