UNDER CONSTRUCTION

Construction at Island Terrace is moving along! As construction continues, please be vigilant for notices and text blasts that will inform you of important upcoming events. UPDATES FOR SEPTEMBER

- The new parking lot is now open—things should get quieter outside — see page 3 for more details.
- Cycle 1 (floors 21-22) has been affected by additional work required at the top floors and the roof. We are in communication with all Cycle 1 residents about being relocated longer than planned.
- **We will have a meeting this month about the schedule delays, everyone is welcome to come and ask questions —please keep an eye out for that date.**
- When the 22nd floor moves back later this fall, we will have an “open house” in the model unit there so residents can see the finishes in the renovated units.
- Floor 20 is in the process of moving to their temporary relocation units so Cycle 2 work can start.
- Floors 18-19 are also part of Cycle 2 and will move out when 21-22 are complete—those floors will be notified when that date is finalized.
- Reconfiguration of the first floor continues. There is new storefront being installed for the new management office (south side of lobby) and community room (north side of lobby).
- The team closed the old entry to the laundry room in order to complete the new and improved laundry room at the northwest corner of the building this fall.
- Elevator interruptions associated with construction workers, movers and deliveries continue. Jim Brower is the operator for Walsh/GMA’s elevator—he is there to ease the elevator pain!
- Heating valve replacements have been completed and units are ready for the cold weather season!
- We are scanning from the odd-numbered floors in September. Please expect our team to enter your unit and scan the floor around the columns in your unit. You will receive a notice before these scans occur.
- Comcast, AT&T, People’s Gas and ComEd upgrades continue.

PARKING LOT MOVE-BACK

The time has come for our new parking lot! The Island Terrace parking lot is now open and the temporary lots are no longer be available for Island Terrace residents to park there. If your car is in a temporary lot, move it to avoid being ticketed and towed!

The general contractors are temporarily keeping the northeast corner of the lot for storage. They will build out the new patio there by next fall. Certain areas will remain fenced off for your safety.

PEST CONTROL SCANNING

With the additional disruption caused by moving, we will be scanning more extensively for pests prior to moves. If needed, we will be employing heat treatments to contain any bedbug cases within each unit before people move out.


Please note that 30 days before you move, we will need to make a full inspection of your home.
