Relocation Update

Here are some important updates about relocation:

- The next floors scheduled for relocation are floors 3–5. Relocation will start later this summer.
- Residents on the 15th and 16th floors previously received 90-day notices. **However, we are no longer following that plan.** We apologize for this change in the plan and thank you for your flexibility as plans change to fit the construction timeline.

As a reminder, no moves will happen without an official 30-day notice from URS. Please feel free to call URS with questions about relocation.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

- Renovations on the 17th-22nd floor are underway.
- Roof work will be happening throughout May and June
- Work on the building's exterior walls is scheduled to begin later this month. **Scaffolding will be installed around the building as part of this work near the end of the month.**
- Near the end of the month there will be another power shutoff. Please be on the lookout for more information regarding this work.

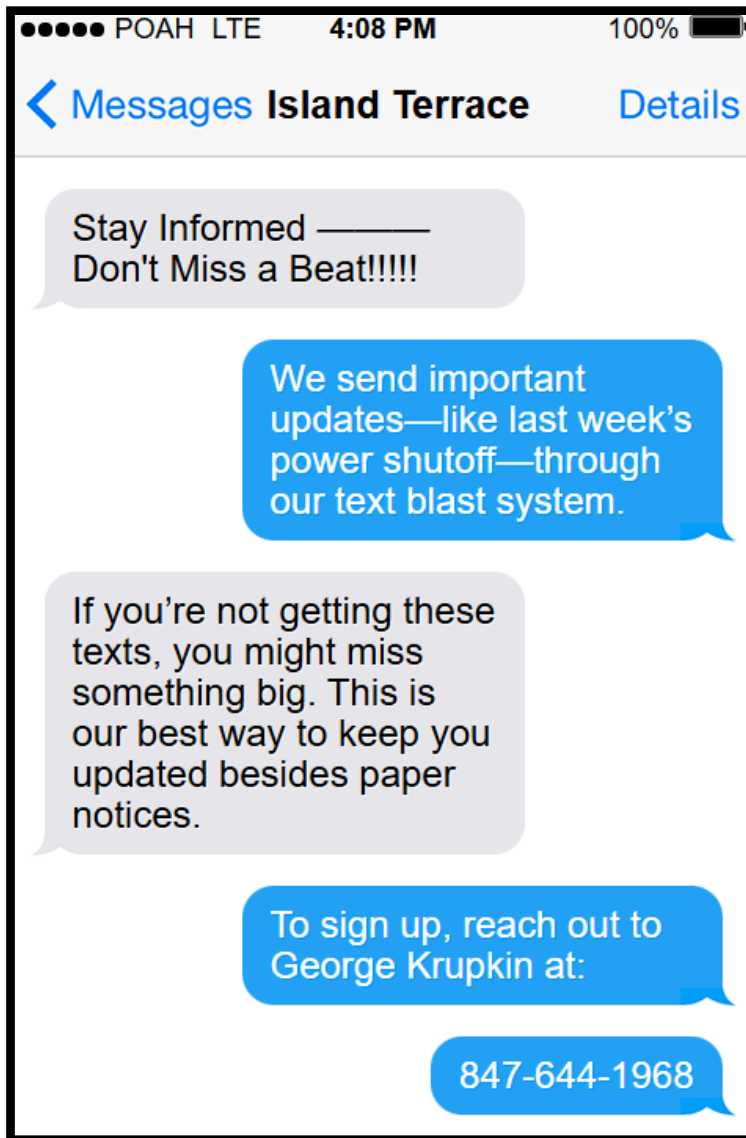


Fun Facts About May
